



Our Mission

The ALPF believes that providing the right information, in the right way, at the right time is critical to helping government officials have the necessary information to make lasting reforms that both enhance our republic and society. In a climate where policymakers are lobbied daily by entities with agendas often contrary to the public interest, the ALPF is working to establish itself as a trusted resource and counterbalance.

Sustainable Leadership Development

The ALPF is committed to developing the leaders America requires to remain strong. We understand the vital role leadership plays in advancing sound policy which in turn strengthens our republic. We must return to the kind of leadership that puts American interests above political expediency.

The purpose of the ALPF leadership development program is to attract and build leaders who will influence the political process in a positive manner. Our program identifies gifted experts and professionals who are willing to apply critical thinking, collaboration, and research to transform America's leadership and policy making climate.

Our leadership development program is intended to directly support emerging leaders through involvement in developing and communicating innovative research solutions, mentoring, networking, and goal setting. New members are

paired with existing ALPF members or fellows based on their interests, skills, and location. And since networking is a vital part of business and politics; future opportunities will include ALPF hosted forums, campus groups, and regional gatherings.

With a shared political outlook, support from ALPF, and sound leadership skills, emerging leaders will be ideally positioned to influence our nation as business professionals, fellows, or public servants in a sustained and meaningful way.

Fellowships

> The ALPF's fellowship program is a central force behind our ability to carry out our mission. Our fellows provide results-based non-partisan policy perspective for America by researching, writing, publishing, and presenting high-quality solutions.

> With experience in nearly every sector, the ALPF's fellows represent a cross-section of the nation's most informed and critical minds. Each ALPF fellow shares an enduring commitment to ensure salient information is provided to the public and their representatives to facilitate well-informed policy development that benefits our citizens. The hallmark of our fellowship program is the emphasis on leadership development, mentoring, and professional improvement.

Fellows are accepted to the ALPF in one of three prestigious roles: (1) Senior Fellow, (2) Full Fellow, or (3) Visiting Fellow. Each position carries a varying degree of responsibility. Only a select few will be admitted as **Senior Fellows**. These members are responsible for producing the groundbreaking research and for the mentorship and development of junior level fellows.

The majority of applicants will be accepted to the role of **Full Fellow**. These members will produce high-caliber research and will initially hold less responsibility with respect to leadership and mentorship as they work closely with Senior Fellows to develop their own talents, quality research, and writing style throughout their tenure.

Visiting Fellows will be brought into the ALPF for a specific project. These fellows will bring to fruition a product that was conceived prior to the start of their fellowship by utilizing ALPF resources necessary for project completion.

All fellows' written work is subjected to internal peer review before publication submission. This process is of inestimable value, both to the Foundation and to individual fellows. The result is a vibrant atmosphere where ideas are exchanged, engaged, encouraged, and at times, debated, and refined.

A New Approach to Research

Proof of Concept

A foundation committed to research by the people for the people. This idea is straightforward and powerful because it uses the talents of our nation's most innovative scholars to help resolve complicated policy issues.

Twelve weeks before Ebola broke in the United States press, ALPF Fellow, H.C. Campbell, a former USAF Intel Analyst, wrote an article predicting that Ebola would reach America's soil by the end of 2014. In addition to describing how it would arrive, Campbell's article proposed many of the ideas that were eventually implemented nationwide to contain the outbreak.

How did Campbell know the timeline, methods of transfer, and practical countermeasures? Because it's his business to scan the globe for emerging threats as a security analyst for a leading energy company. More than a Security Analyst, Campbell is a concerned citizen and professional who realizes the information and perspective he has can be important to all of us.


Proof of Concept

In 2014, an ALPF Senior Fellow published a groundbreaking academic research report on the potential security impacts arising of drone operations in the United States. As a result of interviews with scientists, industry leaders, and military experts - the paper identified a dangerous security gap resulting from the passage of a 2012 bi-partisan federal law.

The study was selected by staff members of the United States House Committee on Homeland Security to educate the Committee Chairman on the need to hold hearings on the threat. Without the report, key decision makers would remain unaware of the need to address this important national security issue.

Experts like Campbell and numerous defense experts, doctors, legal professionals, economists, and scholars across America have joined the ALPF to speak, write, and present on issues because they understand how providing trustworthy information to the right people, at the right time, will benefit *all* Americans.

As a public research fiduciary, the ALPF is committed to fidelity. Our goal is to ensure that **more than 90 percent of every dollar raised directly supports our mission.**

The ALPF is the only foundation of its kind that does not accept special interest or government funding. We succeed because of generous support from concerned citizens like you. However, even individual donations are capped to prevent disproportionate influence on the foundation's governance.

Ethics and Standards

The ALPF takes fidelity seriously and holds all research and analysis to the highest standard. To demonstrate our commitment to world-class quality and sound practices, the Foundation abides by the rigorous code of ethics and practices established by the American Association of Public Opinion Research (AAPOR).

ALPF Fellows also adhere to the ethics of their respective accreditation associations and the Foundation's stringent by-laws. Consequently, ALPF pledges to maintain the highest standard of competence, integrity, and transparency in conducting, analyzing, and reporting our research findings.
