


foundation, too, has encountered many of the challenges confronting wider society. Notwithstanding, our vision remains fixed on service before self.



VISION

To enhance civic engagement and citizen participation through education and the dissemination of public policy information based in open discussion and rigorous verifiable research.

MISSION

To foster the free and full exchange of policy enhancing ideas based in critical thinking. Such ideas will be aided by ALPF in their development and advocacy. These ideas must adhere to the foundation of America's self-governing system and the rule of law.

The ALPF will also function to inform the public at-large on public policy topics including the foundational basis of existing and proposed policies as well as alternative solutions based in American foundational principles.

PHILOSOPHY

The critical functions of our federal government are to provide for the common defense and a secure environment which fosters life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. Our efforts should further these goals. We will also support public law and policy based on constitutional principles with open and participatory change promoted to meet current and future needs within constitutional boundaries.

POLICY RESEARCH

ALPF's public policy focus covers three core areas:


ALPF "OPERATIONALIZES" the practice of leadership.


A record year for outreach & collaboration!
